



DI Announces the NTRACS Burn Registry Product Roadmap And Interfaces to the DI Family of Products

Digital Innovation, Inc. (DI) is excited to announce its product roadmap and preliminary plans for the NTRACS Burn software solution. The initial plan includes a significant software upgrade as well as the development of interfaces for NTRACS Burn that will enable compatibility with DI's family of registry products and modules. The announcement of this plan assures the NTRACS Burn customer base of DI's commitment and its willingness to invest in the long-term success of the NTRACS Burn product.

As part of DI's commitment to the NTRACS Burn customer base, each product release will be governed by the following principles:

- NTRACS Burn customers will receive at *no additional cost* an upgrade path to the next software release.
- Existing registry data will be compatible with each subsequent software release.
- Each upgrade will maintain compatibility with existing reports, queries and user-created interfaces to provide complete investment protection.
- Each release of software will benefit from DI's technical solutions portfolio and will utilize selected components of DI's robust data management platform as well as DI's extensive medical registry feature set.
- The American Burn Association's (ABA) Burn Registry Users Committee will provide clinical input for all NTRACS Burn product updates, upgrades, add-ons and enhancements.

Effective July 1, 2005, DI became directly responsible for the support of the existing NTRACS Burn product as well as the on-going development and enhancement of the NTRACS Burn software package. DI is firmly committed to enhancing the NTRACS Burn product and the American Burn Association (ABA) will collaborate with DI by continuing to provide clinical input into the NTRACS Burn software. Thus, the combination of DI and ABA working together will ensure that your investment in software, data and training is protected and that the NTRACS Burn solution remains viable for the long haul. Additionally, DI has committed to making the needed investments in the NTRACS Burn product to guarantee that the product will continue to be a strong and useful burn registry solution for the foreseeable future.

An aggressive R&D schedule for the NTRACS Burn product has been established. DI's goal is to deliver a significant enhancement for NTRACS Burn customers and will release NTRACS Burn Version 4.0 in November of 2006. An additional goal for DI over the next year will be to develop interfaces so that NTRACS Burn users can enjoy the option of purchasing other DI registry products and modules.

DI is currently meeting with the ABA's Burn Registry Users Committee to determine the full scope of the enhancements for the NTRACS Burn Version 4.0. Discussion areas include:

- Developing a new User's manual for consistency of definitions and data entry
- Determining which patient diagnoses (other than burn) should be included
- Developing Keywords list and other means of capturing information regarding burn etiology
- Building in drop down menus & audit filters to improve the consistency of the data
- Developing ways to make it easier to identify and enter proper ICD procedure codes and DRG's

NTRACS Burn V4.0 will be delivered as part of the existing maintenance contract. In addition, DI is adding interfaces to allow NTRACS Burn users the option of utilizing other DI products and features. The interfaces, developed at DI expense, will afford NTRACS Burn users with the option of purchasing added functionality without having to switch burn registry platforms – another exciting benefit of the NTRACS Burn transition to the DI family.

Existing DI registry modules include:

- DI's Report Writer (Ad Hoc Report Writer and Query Tool).
- Tablet PC Data Entry

Other modules are being reviewed by the Burn Registry Users Committee for possible inclusion as well.
